Curriculum Vitae

I. Personal Data:

I was born in Berlin, January 29 th, 1893. I am of Roman-Catholic faith, married, without children.

II. Training:

I studied the classical languages (Greek and Latin) and the French language at the Universities of Berlin and Dijon (France).  
I took the following degrees:  
1913, Diplôme de Français (honors), University of Dijon (France)  
1919, Final State Examination for Teachership at Secondary Schools,  
University of Berlin (honors),  
1920, Pedagogic State Examination for Teachership at Secondary Schools,  
Berlin (honors),  
1931, Ph.D. (Berlin) cum laude,  
1932, Degree as French interpreter, with the Ministry for Foreign Affairs, Berlin.

Due to German legislation prohibiting, after the first world war, the appointment of young graduates in the teaching profession for a considerable length of time, I specialised in teaching Latin, Greek and French in private, and continued my linguistic studies.

During the years 1933 until 1939 I wrote a word index of the letters and poems of Sidonius Apollinaris (*Index Sidonianus*, see the recommendation published by Professor J. Marouzeau, Paris, Sorbonne, in the "Revue des Etudes Latines", t. IV, p. 264). The manuscript was given to Professor W.A. Oldfather, University of Illinois, who prepared it for publication. Since the death of Prof. Oldfather, the manuscript is in the hands of Professor Kenneth M. Abbott (The Ohio State University).

In 1939, I was forced by the Nazi authorities to leave Germany, and I went to Shanghai (China). There I became a professor of the Latin, Greek, French, and German languages, at the "College Français".

In 1946, I was appointed Professor of French, Latin and German, at the University "L'AMBOINE", which is conducted by the Fathers Jesuits.

In 1948, under a Corporate Affidavit given by the "National Catholic Welfare Committee", I was transferred from Shanghai to San Francisco, Calif., where I arrived on the 12 th May, 1948.

Herr Fritz Kretschmer, geb. d. 29. I 1893 in Berlin Jüd. Religion, bestand die Reifeprüfung zu Michaelis 1911 auf dem Sophien-Gymnasium in Berlin und studierte klassische Philologie und Französisch vom 9.X. 1911 bis 23. X. 1916 in Berlin. (10 Semester).

Seiner militärischen Dienstpflicht genügte er vom 13.V.1915 bis 20.V.1916 beim Infanterieregiment 304 und vom 9.VII.1917 bis 5.XII. 1918 beim Reserveinfanterieregiment 93.

Auf die Meldung vom 4.XII. 1916 zur Prüfung für das Lehramt an höheren Schulen zugelassen, erhält er zu schriftlicher Bearbeitung die Aufgaben:

1. Euripides' Stellung zu den ethisch-religiösen Anschauungen seiner Zeit.

2. De apostrophae apud Euripidem usu.

Der mündlichen Prüfung unterzog er sich am 8.VII.1919 und am 8.III.1930.

Herr Kretschmer hat die Prüfung für das Lehramt an höheren Schulen bestanden und zwar ist ihm nach dem gesamten Ergebnis der schriftlichen und mündlichen Prüfung das Zeugnis

"mit Auszeichnung bestanden"

zuverkannt worden. Er besitzt die Lehrbefähigung im Lateinischen und Griechischen für die erste Stufe, und im Französischen für die zweite Stufe.




Fig. 7b Kretschmer to Oldfather, 22 April 1940 (courtesy Daniel Abosso)




Fig. 7c Oldfather to Kretschmer, 1 June 1940 (courtesy Daniel Abosso)




Fig. 7d Kretschmer to Oldfather, 22 July 1940 (courtesy Daniel Abosso)




Fig. 11 Kretschmer in *Shanghai Emigranten-Adressbuch* (courtesy Kathy York)

In Shanghai, Mr.KRETSCHMER has been professor of French at the University "L'Aurore" which is under the direction of the Society of Jesus. The Rev.Father President has given him a very excellent recommendation which Mr. KRETSCHMER deserves.

Furthermore, Mr. KRETSCHMER has given with great success Latin, Greek, French, and German lessons to many students of the French College of Shanghai.

Of perfect distinction and of irreproachable conduct Mr. KRETSCHMER has all the qualities and knowledge of an excellent professor of the classic ~~xxxxxx~~ languages as well as of French and German. I wish that, in whatever country he may establish himself, he would find the possibility of practicing his profession to which he brings honor.




Fig. 14 Confirmation of furniture and books left after Elisabeth's death (courtesy Kathy York)
